As an international student, you have an obligation to comply with the immigration laws and regulations of the United States. It is illegal to violate U.S. federal immigration laws and regulations for any reason whatsoever. As an international student with F-1 status, you are responsible for learning, understanding, and complying with the U.S. laws and regulations that apply to you. Your failure to be aware of and comply with these requirements could jeopardize your stay in the United States.

You need to remember the following:

() Report address and telephone number changes, to the Office of International Student Services (ISS), within 10 days of any change in your U.S. or home country address and telephone number.

() Keep your passport valid (at least 6 months into the future at all times)

() Always have a valid I-20/DS-2019 Form, if you need an extension you must request an appointment with your

academic advisor, your academic advisor must send a letter to ISS requesting your I-20/DS-2019 to extend.

() Obtain a travel signature as needed (2nd page of your I-20).

() Inform ISS if you end or leave your program before your I-20/DS-2019 expires.

() Abide by employment regulations; meet with your academic advisor if you are planning to register for an internship / clinical rotations etc. Apply for CPT/Academic Training through your international student advisor to obtain authorization before engaging in any internship, clinical rotation etc from an institution other than Barry University.

() Check your Barry University e-mail regularly for updates from ISS and read ISS e-mails carefully, follow up as necessary.

() Make an appointment with an International student's
